The service will be in a big room called the "Schafler Forum."

The shofar is a ram's horn we blow on Rosh Hashanah. Rabbi Ben will blow the shofar.

I can help make shofar sounds with a special shofar song. I can do an art project.



On Rosh Hashanah we eat sweet foods.

There will be apples and honey to eat at the end of the service.
